

The Foundation For Tomorrow Interactive Learning Center:

The Foundation For Tomorrow (TFFT) intends to invest in both the Arumeru community as well as it's people. With plans of completion of this project in late 2011, TFFT intends to invest over \$240,000 USD in order to build, run, and operate the first ever interactive Learning Center in the USA River area.

Not only will there be a contribution to the community that will last for years in the way of this learning center, TFFT's hope is that we will be able to employ a wide variety of people to complete this project. TFFT estimates that over 100 professionals will be hired as a result of this project. This includes, teachers, librarians, contractors, etc. We will be bringing attention to the area that we hope will highlight the need and efficiency of the Arumeru district, and in turn further investment in the District. The center will be comprised of the following:

- 50,000 book Library open to the public
 - ⇒ Both English and Swahili books
 - ⇒ TZ Government School Curriculum Books
 - 20 copies of each courses reading list for Class 1-7 as well as Form 1 – Form 6
 - Both English and Swahili versions of these books
 - ⇒ Fiction, Non-Fiction and Reference Books
- Computer Center (with Wireless Internet and 25 Computers)
 - ⇒ State of the art computer center for reference as well as training
 - ⇒ For both students enrolled in school as well as community members eager to learn new tools
 - Weekly courses to train students and community members of all ages basic computer and typing skills as well as more advanced internet searches, Excel and PowerPoint courses
 - Internet throughout center so those with laptops can bring their own and obtain free access to the internet
- College/University Guidance Center
 - ⇒ Center specifically for student enquiring about higher education options.
 - ⇒ Access and strategic planning to assist Form 6 Students on how they can find scholarships, grants, and alternative funding for university and college options locally, regionally and internationally
 - On-Site Professionals employed through Center to advise Form 6 leavers of options of higher education
 - Resource Center for financial aid opportunities as well as Scholarship Opportunities for Universities and Colleges through Africa, Europe and the United States
 - Approved Testing Center for TOEFL, SAT, ACT, GRE, and other international required testing for higher learning institutions.
- Teachers Training Facility
 - ⇒ Education starts with the teachers; our training facility will be an accredited program that provides teachers willing to learn and grow their skills an opportunity to do so. This will be a training program that teaches teachers how to get the children to learn the concepts while not focusing on rogue memorization teaching tactics.
 - Courses will range from weekend classes to one off seminars with professionals and scholars from around the globe

- Computer Training Facility
 - ⇒ Basic, Intermediate and Advanced Level Courses for students and community members alike

- After-School Tuition Center
 - ⇒ Focused on TFFT Scholarship Recipients - an outlet for them to receive enhanced training in certain subjects should they struggle with
 - For all Scholarship recipients struggling, TFFT staff will provide tuition during term time as well as throughout their holiday period.

- Full Circle Program for Holistic Education
 - ⇒ An After-School extra curricular program that teaches the ideas of health, nutrition and the environment

- HIV/AIDS and Family Planning Educational Workshops
 - ⇒ Workshops aimed at different target populations to ensure everyone knows their rights, knows the truths and can protect themselves against life threatening diseases
 - Guest Speakers will come to the center at different times throughout the year to inform, educate and enlighten the community about how to protect themselves
 - Class to target not only students and youths but also women and men specific workshops that address health issues they are curious about commissioner
